We need to collect over 1000 units of blood every day to ensure that all patients receive the blood they need for survival. Seasonal blood shortages, especially in the summer, can cause the national blood supply to approach critical levels. As one of the larger Regions in the Red Cross system, the Greater Chesapeake & Potomac Region often needs to supplement our collections with imports from the national blood supply. When the national supply dwindles, we are at risk of not being able to meet our local need.
