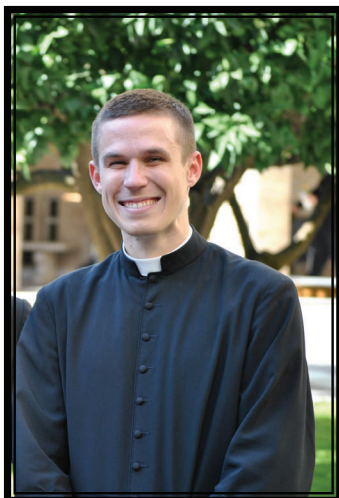
Help Needed: Work Camp 2011 is in need of the following volunteers, can you help us?
