

## DIRECTIONS TO THE CASTLETON RETREAT HOUSE IN VIRGINIA

(approximately 65 miles)

1. D.C. Beltway (I-495) South into Virginia to Exit 9, I-66 West (Manassas, Front Royal)
2. I-66 West about 21 miles to the SECOND exit for Route 29 South; Exit 43A (Wellington)
3. Route 29 South about 15 miles into Warrenton, where it becomes Route 211. After you pass Route 17, stay alert. Route 211 will turn to the right (West) at Howard Johnson's.
4. Continue on Route 211 West (out of Warrenton) about 11 miles. Be vigilant for a small green sign with white lettering that says AMISSVILLE. The sign will be on the right. Just after the sign, make your first left onto Route 642 (Viewtown Road).
5. Stay on Route 642 about three miles until it ends at Route 729. Turn left.
6. Continue on Route 729 about two miles. You'll see a small, former gas station on left. Take the first dirt road on the left after the little gas station. It's called Campground Rd Pvt Ln.
7. In about 4/10ths of a mile, the dirt road bends to the right. Continue another 3/10ths of a mile, and you'll see a covered bridge on the right, as well as the remnants of an outdoor farm equipment museum. Just past the covered bridge, make an immediate (and we mean immediate) left onto a very overgrown, almost hidden driveway. Be careful. It may be bumpy.
8. Continue 2/10ths of a mile to the house.
9. Go toward the right. (If muddy, stop before it gets too deep.)
10. The grey-colored house is on the right side of the hill surrounded by trees. Park in a convenient place. (The house has no specific address. Our neighbor, Mr. and Mrs. Halin, live at 6437 Campground Rd, Castleton, VA 22716). The phone number of the retreat center is (540) 937-2110.
